SPRING IS HERE!– Now that spring is here and warmer weather is just around the corner, it is a great time to revisit the Wascher Dress Code for students. The responsibility for dress and grooming rests with the student and parents. A student's dress or grooming should not affect the safe participation in school classes, programs, other school related activities, or be disruptive to the educational setting. Examples of dress that are **NOT** part of school attire include but are not limited to:

- Clothing that contains obscene or profane language, graphics that are unique to gang affiliation, images of alcohol, tobacco, drugs or weapons of any kind.
- Hats or hoods inside the building (They may wear them outside on the playground)
- Halter tops or spaghetti straps (A good guide is to have straps that are two adult finger widths)
- Shorts that are above the middle of the thigh (A good guide is no shorter than the child's finger tips when their arms are held at their side)
- High heels, flip flops or slippery shoes on P.E. days (For safety reasons, we discourage children from wearing open-toed shoes to school on any day.)
- Pants that are sagging and/or showing undergarments
- Clothing that exposes a child's midriff

If students wear clothing that is in conflict with our dress code, we may ask them to remove or cover the clothing, change their clothes with clean clothing provided by the school, or we may call home to have replacement clothing brought to school. If you have any questions, please give us a call.
